

### CEREC MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

#### **WEEKLY WATER CHANGE**

## At least once a week or when prompted by the system (usually after 240 mins of wet machining time).

- 1. Drain water, rinse, & repeat until the water runs clear.
- Add **75ml Dentatec** to the tank. (150ml if using Dentsply Sirona CEREC **Tessera** blocks).
- Fill the tank with RO water (unless local water is soft) until the filter(s) is/are completely immersed (up to the bottom edge of the filler thread, approx. 3 litres).

If you think the filter(s) need cleaning when changing the water or when the "water pressure too low" message appears, **do not remove the filter** as this can weaken the paper causing tears. Half fill the tank with warm water and slosh to agitate. Drain, rinse and repeat until the water runs clear.

## Change the filter(s) immediately if damaged; otherwise, monthly as advised above.

Clean the motor water jets if they do not strike the machining instruments by carefully removing any foreign particles from the water nozzles with a cleaning wire or probe. This will help to extend the life of the instruments.

#### MONTHLY FILTER REPLACEMENT

# Replace water filter monthly or as needed depending on usage (change filter after approx. 40 mills).

- 1. Add **MC Care Liquid** as indicated on cap measure, direct to the mill chamber.
- 2. Manually run water pump for 5-10 minutes.
- 3. Remove water tank, drain the water, and re-insert water tank.
- **4.** Run the pump again until all of the water is out of the system for approx. 30 secs.
- 5. Remove tank, drain plug and drain into sink. Replace tank drain plug.
- Remove filler cap with tank cap opener (tool 6280171) and half fill with warm tap water. Replace filler cap and slosh. Remove tank drain plug and drain again.



Repeat until water runs clear and no ceramic residue left in the tank. A brush can be used to remove stubborn ceramic deposits – advise removing filter, drain, and filler cap and submerging in a suitable sink e.g. Decontamination room.

- 7. Remove filter(s) with **tool 6280171** and discard paper filter. Filter insert (metal spring or grey plastic tube) and plastic filter cap.
- 8. NEW FILTER(S)

Add a small amount of grease (if available) GREASE UNISILKON - LCA 3801 (6501261) to internal hole of filter, threads, and black o-ring.



- Insert new filter and tighten firmly by hand.
   Do NOT use tool, over-tightening can damage the tank.
- **10.** Ensure drain plug is inserted, measure 75ml of Dentatec and pour directly into tank.
- 11. Fill with **RO water** (unless local water is soft) to bottom of filler opening.
- **12.** Replace tank and run water pump to remove air from the system prior to milling. Check water level in tank and top up if necessary.
- 13. The unit is now ready to use.
